
About the Crystal - Serpentine - By Roger Joyeux

Serpentine is among the healing stones. Through the vibration of its shade of green, it works to produce a healing with particular characteristics. The frequencies of Peridot or Adventurine, for example, offer healing with no sense of complexity. In contrast, Serpentine seeks to wend its way through areas of blockage within the body's physical form. Its work is done without a uniform sense of its purpose. That is, Serpentine meanders through bodily form of any description until it encounters blockages that need healing. In these locations, the stone's vibration goes to work, but initially, only at the periphery of the blockage. It works to move the bodily form that it encounters ever faster---it accelerates the vibration of the surface layers of form. Thereafter, it accelerates progressively deeper layers as its influence creeps towards the core of the blockage.

As Serpentine accelerates form's essence, light then enters. This is what can be reasonably expected. That is, light enters form that vibrates faster. Yet, in addition, the light that is indigenous to the form that suffers from the blockage interacts with the substance of the Serpentine. It enters the serpentine where it undergoes its own reconditioning and healing. The newly-restored light frequencies return to the area of blockage, re-enter its space (first on the surface then deeper) and create balance. It returns the bodily form to its healed state in harmony with the overall state of the being's evolution.

Although Serpentine meanders ad hoc throughout the body's form, it moves according to polar charges. To understand the complexity of how Serpentine works with polarity to effect its healing, come to the Crystal's Light workshop. Understanding crystals goes a long way to understanding the light we work with here on Earth.
